From City Hall:

The following minutes are from the November 8th business meeting. As of print time the minutes have not been approved by the council.

CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL: The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Dustin Wright. Council members present were NUESSEN, HAMLIN, BURTON, and HINRICHS. HARMON was absent. Also present were City Clerk Jana Smart, City Attorney Steve Atherton, City Treasurer Brian Anstey, and maintenance Nick Gadino.

VISITORS/PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: Cheryl Henry arrived at 7:04 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: October 11th business meeting. Moved by NUESSEN to approve the October 11th business meeting. Motion seconded by HINRICHS. 5-0 vote.

BILLS TO PAY: Moved by HINRICHS to approve the accounts payable for November 2022 in the amount of \$10,275.82. Motion seconded by NUESSEN, 5-0 vote.

REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

MAINTENANCE: They have been busy winterizing, finishing up patching roads, and working on ordering the replacement fire hydrant.

PROJECT PLAYSCAPE: HINRICHS would like approval to place Match Day signs at the corner of First Street coming into town and at the NW corner of the City Park. The goal for Match Day is \$16,000 so they can order Splash Pad supplies. Volunteers have been busy assembling the bleachers at the ballfield and will continue to work on them on Friday, November 11th. There will be a pancake and biscuit and gravy breakfast this Sunday, November 13th at Harry & Lloyd's.

CLERK: We issued 26 building permits for roofs in October. Cindy will be in soon for the audit. The employee's health insurance through Blue Cross and Blue Shield is up 13.5% for 2023.

ADOPT THE AGENDA: Moved by HINRICHS to adopt the agenda. Motion seconded by BURTON, 5-0 vote.

- 1. CHRISTMAS PARADE: The annual Christmas parade is scheduled for December 3rd. HINRICHS has asked for \$150 for Santa's travel expenses. The consensus is to pay \$150 for Santa's travel expenses. Will also need the road closed for the parade. Moved by BURTON to close Main Street from Walnut to Broadway on December 3rd from 6-8 p.m. contingent upon the ok from the county. Motion seconded by HARMON. 5-0 vote.
- 2. CASEY'S CMB LICENSE RENEWAL: The city has received everything needed to renew the CMB license for 2023 and there have been no filed complaints. Moved by HAMLIN to renew Casey's CMB License for 2023. Motion seconded by HARMON. 5-0 vote.


NEW POLICY in effect:




