The following minutes are from the January 12th business meeting. As of print time the minutes have not been approved by the council.

CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL: Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Dustin Wright. Those present in person were Mayor Dustin Wright, Council member BIRK, City Clerk Marcia Johnson and maintenance Nick Gadino. Those present via ZOOM were Council members NUESSEN, HAMLIN and BURTON. HINRICHS arrived at 7:04 p.m. Also present via zoom was City Attorney Steve Atherton.

VISITORS/PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: No visitors present.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: December 8, 2020 business meeting. Moved by NUESSEN to approve the minutes. Motion seconded by HAMLIN, 4-0 vote.

BILLS TO PAY: Moved by HAMLIN to approve the bills for January in the amount of \$13,851.73. Motion seconded by BIRK, 4-0 vote.

REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES: BIRK reported from maintenance, on New Year's Day the maintenance department worked snow call, they have taken alternative time off. A new door has been installed in the shop building, the old door had gaps all around letting air in.

City Clerk reported that the owner of a boat that was removed from a property during cleanup has been located. City Clerk is attempting to make contact with the owner for removal. The City has received the title to the oil tanker and has sent the title to Purple Wave. Once they receive the title the oil tanker will be put up for auction.

ADOPT THE AGENDA: Moved by HINRICHS to adopt the agenda. Motion seconded by NUESSEN, 5-0 vote.

- 1. **MAINTENANCE:** *Approval of road material expenditure.* At the end of 2020, \$23,552.73 was encumbered for streets along with \$10,000 for Main Street parking improvements. Moved by BIRK to allow the maintenance supervisor to spend up to \$23,552.73 for road materials as needed and wisely. Motion seconded by HINRICHS, 5-0 vote.
- 2. FILED COMPLAINT: 409 Oak. A complaint has been filed on the property at 409 Oak for junk including vehicles. City building inspector along with the Code Enforcement/Police Chief Jody Meyers performed an inspection of the property. The legal owner of each vehicle will be served for a junk vehicle violation notice and begin the process to correct the violation. Code Enforcement will then revisit the property to determine if other code violation are present.
- 3. **RESOLUTION 278:** *Adopting the Kansas Homeland Security Region I Hazard Mitigation Plan.* Moved by BURTON to adopt Resolution 278, Kansas Homeland Security Region I Hazard Mitigation Plan. Motion seconded by NUESSEN, 5-0 vote.
- 4. **RESOLUTION 279:** *GAAP Waiver for the 2020 audit.* Moved by HINRICHS to adopt resolution 279. Motion seconded by NUESSEN, 5-0 vote.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: *Non-elected personnel matters.* Moved by to go into executive session for non-elected personnel matters for 10 minutes, with council, mayor and legal present at 7:20 p.m.

Back in regular session at 7:30 p.m.

Moved by BURTON to adjourn at 7:32. Motion seconded by NUESSEN, 5-0 vote.




