MINUTES AMERICUS CITY COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING TUESDAY, APRIL 12, 2022 CITY HALL 7:00 PM

CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL: The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Dustin Wright. Council members present were HAMLIN, HINRICHS, NUESSEN, and BURTON. One vacant seat. Also present were City Clerk Jana Smart, City Treasurer Brian Anstey, City Maintenance Nick Gadino, and City Attorney Steve Atherton. VISITORS/PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: No visitors

ADOPT THE AGENDA: Moved by HINRICHS to adopt the agenda. Motion seconded by NUESSEN, 4-0 vote

MINUTES AMERICUS CITY COUNCIL BUSINESS MEETING TUESDAY, APRIL 12, 2022 CITY HALL 7:00 PM

CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL: The meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m. by Mayor Dustin Wright. Council members present were HAMLIN, HINRICHS, NUESSEN, and BURTON. One vacant seat. Also present were City Clerk Jana Smart, City Treasurer Brian Anstey, City Maintenance Nick Gadino, and City Attorney Steve Atherton.

VISITORS/PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: Cindy Kearns arrived at 7:09 p.m. Chris Howard arrived at 7:11 p.m. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** March 8, 2022 business meeting and March 15th special meeting.

3/8/22 meeting-Moved by BURTON to approve the minutes. Motion seconded by HINRICHS, 4-0 vote.

3/15/22 meeting-Moved by HAMLIN to approve the minutes. Motion seconded by NUESSEN, 4-0 vote.

BILLS TO PAY: Moved by NEUSSEN to approve the bills in the amount of \$31,729.11. Motion seconded by BURTON, 4-0 vote.

REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

PROJECT PLAYSCAPE: HINRICHS reports backstop poles are in, waiting on the shell to put up the backstop fence. Dugout poles are in as well. HINRICHS is waiting to talk to Mark with Richmor Lawncare, she thinks he should be about ready to seed. Some volunteers went out and picked up rocks in the outfield this past weekend. Some of the walls were knocked out in the shower rooms to make room for more bathroom stalls. Waiting on the doors to be shipped so they can be installed. They will be cleaning out the storage room soon to put new shelves and totes in for more organization and also cleaning out the concession stand.

PARKS: Gerald Schumann Electric is working on the basketball court lights to get the timer working properly and adjust the angle of the lights.

ADOPT THE AGENDA: Moved by HAMLIN to adopt the agenda. Motion seconded by BURTON, 4-0 vote.

2. JOANNA MILLER: Rock hiding group

Joanna Miller is a 10-year-old who lives in NLC. She is interested in starting a rock hiding group in the area. It would consist of hiding painted rocks. When you find someone's rock, you take a picture of it and post it on the Facebook page. The Facebook page would promote safe spots to hide rocks where mowers would not hit them. Then you have the option to keep it or re-hide it. She is also contacting surrounding towns to have groups started there. She is even willing to host a few rock painting meetings where kids could meet and make friends and paint rocks. There is no action needed council just wanted people to be aware.

3. APPOINTMENT: Open council seat.

The City of Americus received two applications for the vacant city council seat. Council reviewed both and felt the applications were acceptable, and both would do a good job if hired. Prior to the vote, it was determined that one applicant unfortunately is currently working on a project for the City of Americus, therefore would not be eligible to fill the seat. Mayor Wright appointed Bill Harmon to the open City Council seat with Council consent. Bill will be notified and welcomed at the next meeting.

4. USD #251: Preschool crosswalk

USD #251 is wanting to put in a crosswalk from the preschool to the other side of the street so the kids don't have to walk through the parking lot. The total cost of the project is \$1273.45. The crosswalk will be located in the city easement between the two properties at 551 Broadway and 557 Broadway. NUESSEN asked Jana to check with Laverne about the budget and table until the next meeting.

5. COMMUNITY JUNK JAMBOREE

Raymond Paige approached the council at the December 2021 meeting about having a type of flea market once a month during the summer. Council was thinking about maybe combining it with the city-wide garage sales and letting people sell at the park. HINRICHS is concerned about who is going to run it. With it being on city property, insurance is a concern as well as the work that it entails. When they did the vendor booths around Christmas they had to compile a list of names and all information, gave a packet with tax information so vendors could report how much they made and Marcia had to give out tax sheets. HIN-RICHS suggested putting together a community committee to put it on. Talk to the insurance carrier and see if they have a problem with having it in the park if someone else heads it up and would not be a city-sponsored event.


6. PURCHASE OF LAWN MOWER






