BUILDING PERMIT CHECK LIST

Before Permit Can Be Issued:

- 1. Application for Building Permit must be received and paid for in full.
- 2. Sewer tap application and fee of \$50 must be paid at the time application is submitted.
- 3. Blue prints, description and layout of the project must be submitted. Drawings are to include where utility lines are located.

Before Construction Can Begin:

- 1. Building Permit must be issued, and posted on the property visible from the street.
- 2. Building official will inspect the property and approve the layout of the project.
- 3. All contractors must have a current Contractor's License with the City.

Things to Know About Building Your Project:

- 1. ____ Minimum footings shall be 8 inches wide and 36 inches deep, as per City Code Chapter 4, Article 2, Section 4-203a.
- 2. ____ The setback requirements are 25 feet off of the property line on a street side and 8 feet off of the property line on private property or alleyway sides. *These measurements are taken from your property lines*. If the building official is in question, proof of the property pins will be required at *your* expense. Single family residential zones shall have a back yard of 20' for the main residence.
- 3. ____ Building Permits are active for six months, at the time of expiration an extension may be issued for half the cost of the original permit.
- 4. ____ Accessory building may be constructed in accordance with the Cities Zoning & Subdivision Regulations; Article X Section 5. LOT COVERAGE: The principal building and accessory buildings shall not cover more than thirty-five (35) percent of the lot area. Contact City Hall for property in a zone other than single family residential.
- 5. Carports are subject to building setbacks and permit requirements.
- 6. A final inspection and a "Certificate of Occupancy" must be issued before the owner is to move in.
- 7. Modular and Mobile homes must be HUD approved.
- 8. Modular homes must be on a permanent foundation.
- 9. Single wide mobile homes are allowed only in certain areas of town. Check with City Hall for location.
- 10. Homes built off site must have a Third party inspection certificate.
- Before a culvert may be installed the site and culvert size is to be approved by the city. Culverts may be purchased from the city. For a current price list stop in or call City Hall.
- 12. ___ There is to be 10' space between buildings.
- 13. An excavation permit will be required if excavation takes place on city easement.
- 14. ____ Buildings under 120 sq. ft. do not require a building permit, yet must still follow the set backs.
