MINUTES AMERICUS CITY COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 2022 – 7:00 P.M. CITY HALL

CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL: The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Dustin Wright. Council members present were HINRICHS, BURTON, and HARMON. Council members HAMLIN and NUESSEN were absent. Also present were City Clerk Jana Smart, City Attorney Steve Atherton, City Treasurer Brian Anstey, maintenance Nick Gadino, and City Accountant Laverne Soetebier. NUESSEN arrived at 7:02 p.m.

VISITORS/PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: No visitors present.

ADOPT THE AGENDA: Moved by BURTON to adopt the agenda. Motion seconded by HARMON, 3-0 vote.

1. **2023 BUDGET:** *Revenue Neutral Rate.* The Revenue Neutral Rate is based on the amount raised from the previous year. The RNR for Americus was calculated as 32.412 mills. The city shall levy a property tax rate exceeding the RNR by 2.913 mills for a rate of 35.325. Resolution #288 allows the city to levy a property tax rate exceeding the revenue neutral rate. Moved by BURTON to approve resolution 288. Motion seconded by HINRICHS, 4-0 vote. A vote on the resolution was taken by a roll call vote.

Moved by BURTON to adjourn at 7:04 p.m. Motion seconded by HINRICHS, 4-0 vote.

CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL: The meeting was called to order at 7:06 p.m. by Mayor Dustin Wright. Council members present were HINRICHS, NUESSEN, BURTON, and HARMON. Council member HAMLIN was absent. Also present were City Clerk Jana Smart, City Attorney Steve Atherton, City Treasurer Brian Anstey, maintenance Nick Gadino, and City Accountant Laverne Soetebier.

VISITORS/PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: *Jeff Shirley*. Mr. Shirley was present to express concern over the ad valorem tax notice that was sent out by the county. Mr. Shirley left at 7:14 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: August 9, 2022 business meeting & August 16, 2022 special meeting Moved by NUESSEN to approve the minutes for the August meetings. Motion seconded by BURTON. 3-0-1 vote. HINRICHS abstained. Laverne left at 7:18 p.m.

BILLS TO PAY: Moved by HARMON to pay the September bills in the amount of \$39,715.15. Motion seconded by NUESSEN, 4-0 vote.

REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

PROJECT PLAYSCAPE: HINRICHS reported that they are almost finished with the fencing. The shelter house is up, the plumbing is all done, and the lights are all functional. Project Playscape will be kicking-off fundraisers for the next couple of months as we will be able to use any funds raised for Match Day. There will be a volunteer weekend to put bleachers together at the ballfield.

MAINTENANCE: They have been busy working on mowing, spraying, and weed-eating. Chip and seal is almost complete for the year, there are just a few areas to touch up.

- CRASE TRAINING: (Civilian response to active shooter events) This course was designed and built on the Avoid, Deny, Defend (ADD) strategy developed by ALERRT in 2004, providing strategies, guidance, and a proven plan for surviving an active shooter event. Topics include the history and prevalence of active shooter events, civilian response options, medical issues, and considerations for conducting drills. There was some interest in the training course. HINRICHS will check more into it. This would be available for a training session with the council and fire department.
- 2. EXECUTIVE SESSION: *Non-elected personnel matters* Moved by HINRICHS to go into executive session at 7:26 p.m. not to exceed 10 minutes with council, mayor, and legal present to discuss non-elected personnel matters. Motion seconded by NUESSEN. 4-0 vote.






