

From City Hall:

The following minutes are from the August 9th business meeting. As of print time the minutes have not been approved by the council.

CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL: The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Dustin Wright. Council members present were NUESSEN, HAMLIN, BURTON, and HARMON. HINRICHS was absent. Also present were City Clerk Jana Smart, City Attorney Steve Atherton, City Treasurer Brian Anstey, and maintenance Nick Gadino.

VISITORS/PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: Russell Torrens

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: *July 12th special business meeting.* Moved by BURTON to approve the July 12th special business meeting. Motion seconded by HARMON. 4-0 vote.

BILLS TO PAY: Moved by HARMON to approve the accounts payable for August 2022 in the amount of \$107,458.94. Motion seconded by NUESSEN, 4-0 vote.

REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

- 1. MAINTENANCE: BURTON reported they have done one tanker for chip seal and would like to do another one. Maintenance has done 14 blocks so far. Nick has gotten estimates for another tanker and will get it ordered.
 - 2. ADOPT THE AGENDA: Moved by HAMLIN to adopt the agenda. Motion seconded by NUESSEN, 40 vote.
 - **3 REZONING REQUEST:** *Mile Marker Rentals* Russell Torrens is here for Mile Marker Rentals. Mile Marker Rentals has applied for a zoning change for Block 89, lots 10 12 from Residential Division 2 (two family) to Residential Division 3 (multi-family). They would like to put in another duplex in town behind the existing one. The Planning & Zoning Board has held a public hearing and is sending to the council a recommendation to approve the zoning change. Ordinance no. 613 would rezone block 89, lots 10-12 from residential division 2 to residential division 3. Moved by HAMLIN to adopt Ordinance 613, Motion seconded by BURTON, 4-0 vote.
 - **4. SPONSORSHIP:** *Emporia Gazette* Moved by HAMLIN to approve all 3 sponsorships. Motion seconded by HARMON, 4-0 VOTE.
- **5. STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE:** *Adoption of Ordinance #611* Moved by HARMON to adopt Ordinance #611 (Standard Traffic Ordinance). Motion seconded by NUESSEN, 4-0 vote.

UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE: *Adoption of Ordinance #612* Moved by NUESSEN to adopt Ordinance #612 (Uniform Public Offense Code). Motion seconded by BURTON, 4-0 vote.




NEW POLICY in effect:
