CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL: The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President HAMLIN Council members present were HARMON, HAMLIN, NUESSEN, and HINRICHS. Also present were Interim City Clerk Dodie Doudna, and Attorney Steve Atherton. VISITORS/PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: Vicki Brickell ADOPT THE AGENDA: Moved by NUESSEN to adopt the agenda. Motion seconded by HINRICHS. 3-0 vote. 1.2026 BUDGET: Proposed budget for adoption. Moved by HARMON to adopt the 2026 Proposed Budget. Motion seconded by HINRICHS. 3-0 vote. Motion to adjourn budget hearing at 7:04 p.m. by NUESSEN. Motion seconded by HINRICHS. 3-0 vote.

VISITORS/PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: Vicki Brickell APPROVAL OF MINUTES: July 8th, 2025, business meeting Moved by HARMON to approve the July 8th, 2025, business meeting minutes. Motion seconded by HINRICHS. 4-0 vote. July 10th, 2025 and July 24th, 2025 special meeting Moved by NUESSEN to approve the July 10th and July 24th special meeting minutes. Motion seconded by HARMON. 4-0 vote. BILLS TO PAY: Moved by HINRICHS to approve the July bills to pay for \$14,909.83. Motion seconded by HARMON. 4-0 vote. REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES: PROJECT PLAYSCAPE: HINRICHS reported that they finished the tour for kids. Vintage baseball game will be Saturday, August 16th. HAMLIN mentioned that in the 2027 baseball season, high school teams will start using the double first base like softball does. She would like to encourage the rec to incorporate this at the younger ages to get them used to it before high school. MAINTENANCE: CLERK: Dodie Doudna presented several trainings that she would like to attend in the upcoming months. Council agreed these would be good opportunities to learn the role more. Nick and Harmon will try to repair them. 3.CONDEMNATION: 507 Elm: Council would like the building inspector to inspect the property to decide if it is a dangerous and unfit structure. 1010 Main: Clerk will reach out to owner for update on repairs/demolition. 503 and 511 Main: Clerk will reach out to owner for update on repairs. 4.ORDINANCE 623: Rewording for clarity HARMON proposed some changes to the Open Buring Policy for clarity for residents. Attorney Steve Atherton advised that once the wording is changed that the Open Burn Policy be adopted into Ordinance 623. 














4 BEDROOM FLOOR PLAN




